1st - 3rd Dan - Physical and Written Exam

Written Exam:

• Each Dan has a specific exam for their level

Essay:

- Topic of your choice. Must be approved by your head instructor
 Suggestions your journey to becoming a black belt, learning journey, etc.
- Minimum four pages, single-spaced, font size 10
- Printed and electronic copies

Part 1: Skipping, Push-ups, and Sit-ups

- Skipping three (3) rounds at 2-minute per round (1-minute rest between rounds)
- Push-ups five (5) rounds of 50 push-ups in 1-minute (1-minute rest between rounds)
- Sit-ups five (5) rounds of 50 sit-ups in 1-minute (1-minute rest between rounds)

Part 2: Run

- 1st Dan running 3.2 km in 18 minutes or under (8 laps on track)
- 2nd Dan running 6.4 km in 36 minutes or under (16 laps on track)
- 3rd Dan running 10 km in 60 minutes or under (25 laps on track)
- All Dans 200 metre sprint right after running requirements are met

(1/2 lap on track)

4th - 8th Dan - Physical Exam (not required)

No physical and/or written exam required for 4th – 8th Dan



1st Dan - Technical Exam

Requirements:

- Minimum of 2 years training
- Fulfill duty as an assistant instructor by assisting the colour belt classes and your dojang's events
- Attend one of the following CHITF-sanctioned events: Seminar, National / International Tournament

Patterns:

• all colour belt patterns

Sparring:

- Step sparring
 - o 3-step sparring: yellow stripe to green stripe
 - o 2-step sparring: green belt
 - 1-step sparring: green belt to black stripe
- Free sparring
 - o 1 vs. 1
 - o 2 (or more) vs. 1

Self-defence:

- White to black stripe techniques
- Knife defence (ice pick and upward stab)

Breaking:

- Power (two to three 1-inch boards): hand or foot technique
- Special (one to two thin boards):
 - o If one board: suspended, flying sidekick (height or distance)
 - o Two boards: multiple targets in the air

2nd Dan – Technical Exam

- Fulfill duty as an assistant instructor by assisting the colour belt classes and your dojang's events
- Attend one of the following CHITF-sanctioned events: Seminar, National / International Tournament (compete and umpire), Umpire Course

Patterns:

- Two random colour belt patterns
- All three 1st dan patterns

Sparring:

- Step sparring: create three from each 1st dan pattern
- Model sparring: create three with a minimum of three counterattacks
- Free sparring
 - o 1 vs. 1
 - o 2 (or more) vs. 1

Self-defence:

Against knife

Breaking:

- Power (three to four 1-inch boards): hand or foot technique
- Special (one to three thin boards):
 - o If one board: suspended, flying sidekick (height or distance)
 - o Two to three boards: multiple targets in the air

- Free sparring
 - o 1 vs. 1
 - o 2 (or more) vs. 1

Self-defence:

Against knife, stick defence, and multiple opponents

Breaking:

- Power (four to five 1-inch boards): hand or foot technique
- Special (one to four thin boards):
 - o If one board: suspended, flying sidekick (height or distance)
 - o Two to three boards: multiple targets in the air

- Must be approved by a CHITF grandmaster, senior master or master. If the country does not have a CHITF master, an application must be sent to CHITF Headquarters. CHITF Headquarters will appoint an authorized examiner to administer the exam. If an examiner can't be found, then a virtual exam via Zoom or pre-recorded video will be considered in a case-by-case scenario
- Attend one of the following CHITF-sanctioned events: National / International Course, International or national tournament (compete and umpire), Umpire Course

CHITF Headquarters will appoint an authorized examiner to administer the exam. - Must be approved by CHITF Promotion Board
 - Application must include copies of CHITF Instructor and Umpire certificates
- Attend the following CHITF-sanctioned events: International Instructor Course,
 National/International tournament (compete and umpire), and Umpire Course.

8th Dan - Technical Exam Senior Master

Requirements:

- Minimum of 7 years of training
- Must be approved by a CHITF Promotion Board
 - o CHITF will reach out to the individual, notifying them of their eligibility. No one should ask for their 8th dan promotion
- Must show leadership, services, contributions, and community work to further develop CHITF and Taekwon-Do

- Topic of your choice. Must be approved by your head instructor: Suggestions - journey to becoming a Grand Master, becoming a school owner, etc.
- Minimum four pages, single-spaced, font size 10
- Printed and electronic copies
